Val Swail is an Emeritus Scientist with the Climate Research Division of Environment and Climate Change Canada in Toronto. He was the Chair of the JCOMM Expert Team on Waves and Coastal Hazard Forecasting Systems (ETWCH) from 2001-12, and remains on that Expert Team as vice-Chair. He is the co-chair of the DBCP-ETWCH Pilot Project on Wave measurement Evaluation and Test (PP-WET) which is the subject of this presentation, and also the co-chair of the WMO Coastal Inundation Forecasting Demonstration Project (CIFDP) which has been dealing with development of forecast early warning systems for waves and storm surges, including Fiji, which will be much higher profile after the events of last weekend's encounter with TC Winston!
